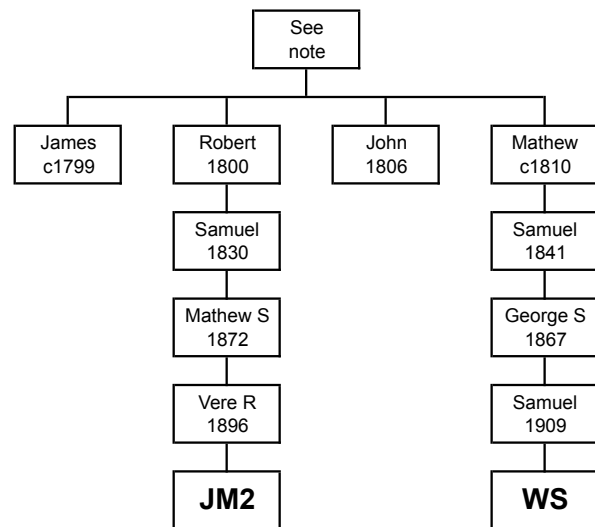
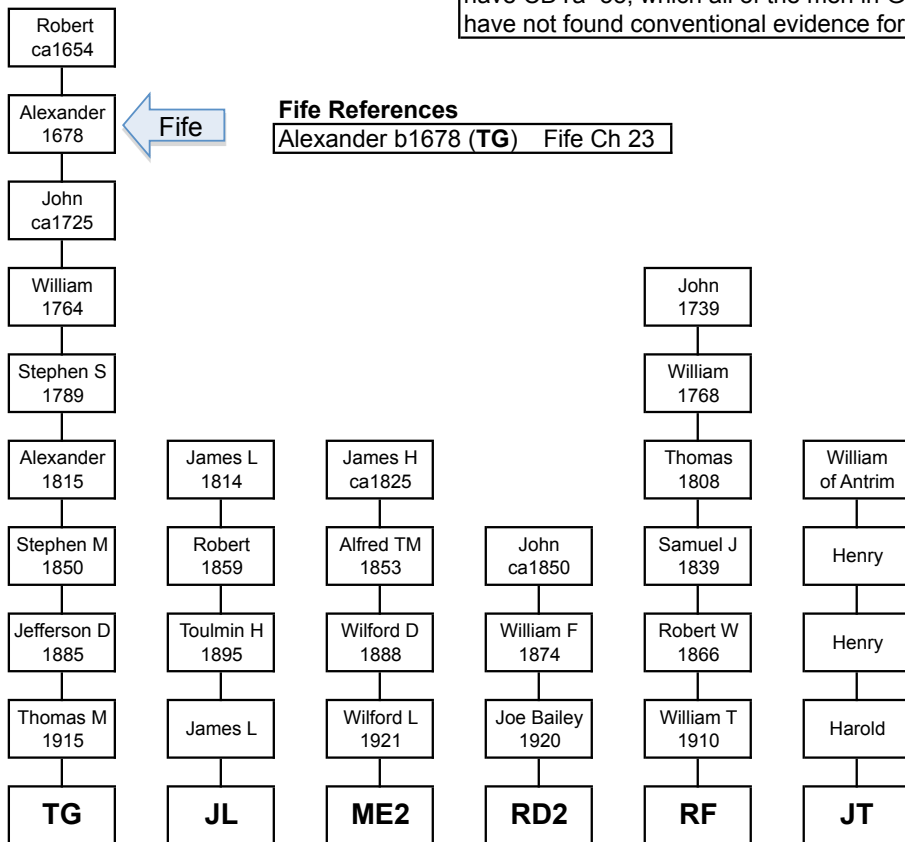
These men all are close matches with the Ewing modal and have DYS 391=10, which puts them in Group 2, but we do not know their conventional genealogic connections with one another or the others in Group 2. Note that ME2 has CDYb=37, which is characteristic of some of the men in Group 2a, but he does not have CDYa=35, which all of the men in Group 2a have, and we have not found conventional evidence for a connection with them.
